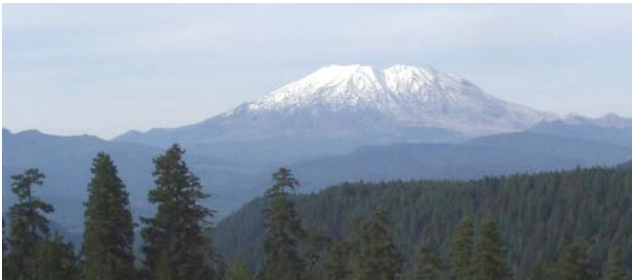


#2 STERNWHEELER DINNER CRUISE w/stop at MULTNOMAH FALLS
